SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY**

September 2025

We are committed to making our school uniform as accessible as possible for all of our families, whilst making sure our children are smart and ready to learn.

There are photos on our school website of the uniform items mentioned.

The Year 1 and Year 2 school uniform is as follows:

- White polo shirt with or without school logo.
- Grey shorts/trousers/skirt/pinafore dress
- Bottle green round necked sweatshirt or green cardigan with or without the school logo
- White, grey or black socks. Bottle green, white or grey tights may also be worn.
- For Summer Bottle Green/White gingham dress.
- Flat black school shoes – no open toed sandals.
- Wellington Boots. Children will require access to Wellington boots throughout the school year.
- A warm coat or rain coat
- Optional school sun hat or winter hat
- Optional school jacket

Reception Year

In the Foundation Stage (Reception), all pupils wear:

Black tracksuit trousers (jogging bottoms) or leggings instead of dresses/skirts, grey shorts/trousers. This is because of the amount of time spent in the outdoor learning areas.

Reception children will need wellington boots and school shoes that cover the entire foot. Velcro fasteners are preferred.

During periods of exceptionally warm weather a note or email will be issued by the Headteacher to parents advising of any changes to Reception uniform.

P.E. (All Children)

- White T- shirt.
- Black shorts.
- Black plimsolls – Reception children will require these from October Half Term.
- These need to be kept in a drawstring bag marked with the child's name.
- Dark coloured tracksuit in the winter. Not required in Reception.

Jewellery

Ear-rings (except plain gold studs) may not be worn as these can be a hazard and can be easily lost. Any studs must be covered or removed by the child before each PE lesson.

Reception children are required to have stud ear-rings covered at all times and parents are required to cover any studs with tape before their child enters school.

Watches are not permitted.

If any child is required to wear jewellery for religious purposes, please contact the Headteacher to discuss the requirement.

Beauty products

Nail varnish and make up should not be worn to school.

Keeping costs down:

Our uniform is available from PMG Schoolwear in High Wycombe.

The PTA regularly runs pre-loved sales of uniform. Items of pre-loved uniform are sold for a fraction of their original cost – for example school jumpers are usually £1. In addition to being cost effective we actively encourage re-use of school uniform as this is more environmentally friendly.

Book bags are sold by our PTA and can be ordered through the School Office.

Parents are free to purchase equivalent items from other shops, suppliers or supermarkets if suitable alternatives are available at lower cost.

Children can wear items without a logo, and plain white polo shirts, green cardigans and green jumpers can be bought at high street stores and supermarkets.

Equality and Religious needs

Please speak to the Headteacher if you have particular needs in relation to the school uniform. Most needs can be accommodated with small adjustments. We want all of our children to feel welcomed and comfortable.

Items of religious headwear are permitted in either black or bottle green colours.

Hairstyles

Children with long hair should have this tied back for health and safety reasons.

Children should not have their hair dyed.

Pupils may wear bows, headbands etc but these should be bottle green or a neutral colour. If hair accessories are too large we may ask your child to remove them.
